LAW

TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT SOME PROVISIONS OF LAW No. 2004/5 OF 21 APRIL 2004 TO LAY DOWN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING MEMBERSHIP OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COUNCIL

SECTION 1: The provisions of Sections 9 and 22 of Law No. 2004/5 of 21 April 2004 to lay down the rules and regulations governing membership of the Constitutional Council are amended and supplemented as follows:

<u>"SECTION 9:</u> (new) Members of the Constitutional Council shall be irremovable. Their term of office of 6 (six) years shall be renewable.

"SECTION 22: (new) (1) In the event of the death or resignation of a member or any other cause of incapacity or inability duly established by the competent bodies provided for by law, a replacement shall be designated by the competent authority or body concerned and appointed to complete the term of office.

- (2) The above provisions notwithstanding, upon the expiry of the said term of office, a member of the Constitutional Council so appointed may be appointed for a new term of 6 (six) years, where the member had served in replacement for a period of less than 2 (two) years.
- (3) In case of resignation from office of a member of the Constitutional Council, such member shall not be eligible for any elective position before the expiry of a period of 3 (three) years, with effect from the date of his resignation".

SECTION 2: This law shall be registered, published according to the procedure of urgency and inserted in the Official Gazette in English and French.
